STEWARDSHIP PRESENTATION

Eligibility Criteria:

- Be a long-term (minimum 2 years), hands-on, environmental stewardship initiative that
 - actively supports a healthy local ecology;
 - actively promotes greening school and community practices;
 - includes an outdoor component.
- Be a school in the Region of Peel. PDSB, DPCDSB, and private schools are eligible - including elementary, middle and/or secondary schools.
- Be a school environmental stewardship that currently includes local community members or has the potential to involve the local community in a community-wide stewardship.
- Be an environmental stewardship that is integrative to school programming and part of the school's education practice (i.e., more than an event or series of events)

Initial Details:

- Complete and submit the application form by May 25th, 2011.
- There will be 9 presentations in the 'Stewardship Tent' throughout the afternoon.
- Applicants selected for interview will be contacted by a member of the EcoFest Stewardship Committee no later than May 30th.
- Nominate at least one adult supervisor to support the presenters (parent, teacher, administrator, etc.) during the presentation and choose 2 school 'Key Staff Contact'.
- The presentation group is to consist of six to ten participants (minimum of 4 students).
- Each group presentation will last 15 minutes (including time to interact with the audience). Participating groups will attend a one-hour session in the Stewardship Tent to present their project and hear other presentations. Organization details (times to present, displays, location, set-up, etc.) will be clarified during the interview.
